We reaffirm our ongoing commitment to justice and reconciliation between Australia's First Peoples and settler populations".

 - recognize that the topics to be covered are challenging for many
 - focus on biblical foundations and avoid pushing any particular political position
 - ensure the process is accessible and engaging for the whole Liquid Community
 - a shorter teaching series on God and Land, Reconciliation, and the people of God's call to the marginalised (starting in August)
 - emphasize a relational approach (dialogue on challenging issues in a safe context) rather than a purely instructional one
 - mid-week 'learning circles' of storytelling and reflection
 - encouraging engagement with local indigenous groups
 - draw on our members and local resource people for stories and perspectives
